Finally, this week both the Senate and the House passed the **three free trade agreements between the United States and Columbia, Panama and South Korea.** Backers of these agreements are predicting that they will create over 250,000 jobs over the next decade. The South Korea deal would boost American exports by as much as **\$10.9 billion** in the first year in which it's in full effect, according to the U. S. International Trade Commission. The accord with Colombia would increase exports as much as **\$1.1 billion a year.** According to the U. S. Chamber of Commerce, these agreements will prevent the loss of 380,000 jobs.

10. **Governor Nathan Deal will lead a delegation to China and South Korea this week on his first Asia trade mission.** The delegation will include Georgia Department of Economic Development Commissioner Chris Cumiskey and others. The visit will take place October 16th-22nd. Korea is Georgia's 11th largest export market and sixth largest

import market. In 2010, Georgia exports to Korea were almost \$632 million - up 39%. 55 Korean facilities operate in Georgia, employing around 5,800 workers. During his trip, **Governor Deal will address the Korean Chamber of Commerce and Industry** China is Georgia's second largest export market with a total near \$2.4 billion in exports 2010. Around two dozen Chinese facilities operate in Georgia. During this portion of the trip, economic development agreements with Shandong Province and the city of Shanghai will be signed.
